

Palo Alto Service Unit 601 Event for Older Girls 16th Annual Ski & Winter Wonderland Trip to Yosemite

Who? All Palo Alto Girl Scouts in 6th-12th grade and chaperoning women.

When? Saturday, January 25th at 6:00 AM until Sunday at 8:00 PM.

What? Enjoy Yosemite Valley Saturday afternoon with your troop and ice skate or sing and play games that evening with 90 other Palo Alto Girl Scouts. Overnight in hard-sided cabins with bathrooms in Yosemite Valley including dinner and breakfast. Ski, snowboard, cross country, snowshoe, tube, and enjoy the snow at Badger Pass Ski Area on Sunday.

Where? Travel from Palo Alto to Yosemite National Park and back again.

How? Chartered bus with reclining seats, DVD player, and bathroom.

\$175/girl, \$120/chaperoning adult. Fees cover bus, sleeping space by troop (4 people share 2 double beds), 2 breakfasts (1 on board bus), Saturday dinner, and snack on return bus. Scholarship help is available (NO questions asked); pay what you can. Bring cash (@\$25) to cover Sunday lunch at Badger Pass plus snacks if desired when bus makes ½ hour stop in Los Banos each way.

- Badger Pass gives us excellent group rates for cross country skiing, downhill skiing, and snow boarding. You pay for snow activity you select -- costs range from \$7.50 for child to rent cross country skis to \$83 for adult downhill ski lift and rental.
- Total fee is due by October 21 including \$50 non-refundable deposit assessed after October 28. Remaining amount can be refunded until December 20. Badger Pass expenses fully refunded if you miss trip, even at the last minute.
